PRESCHOOL FEES

The NSW State Government is targeting Preschools as part of the Start Strong Program that encourages parents to enrol their children into Preschool for at least 600 hours in the year before school. Research shows that children who participate in a quality childhood education program for at least 600 hours in the year before school are more likely to arrive at school equipped with the social, cognitive and emotional skills they need to engage in learning.

Preschool Fees are calculated on the number of days per week of enrolment. Fees for Preschool are charged on a Term basis and are payable on the same schedule as other College fees. The Resources and Activities Levy does not apply to Preschool students. An annual Preschool Equipment Fee of \$55 per child is charged at the beginning of the year or upon commencement.

Please note - There is an expectation that Preschool students attend for a minimum of two days

The Preschool fees listed are not a subsidised daily rate, the subsidised rate which is in accordance with the Start Strong - Affordable Preschool funding guidelines are listed in the Subsidised rates table.

K – 12 TUITION FEES

Annual Tuition fees are billed over 4 instalments except for Year 12 which is billed in 3 instalments.

The Resources and Activities Levy (RAL) include Camps from Years 3-12, in addition to a range of resources and activities provided by the College. The Annual Education Fee does not include co-curricular activities or instrument hire.

UNIFORMS

Uniforms are sold through the College Uniform Shop. The cost of uniforms varies depending on the age and gender of the child. Please refer to the Uniform Price List for further details. Uniforms can be paid either by EFT or credit card. In addition, there are limited second hand items available from the Clothing Pool.
